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TUTORING

Instructors can be available in person or online for tutoring. When arranging a tutoring session, please make sure to include your SU information and the specifics of what you need help with so the faculty can be prepared during your session.

If you set an appointment but are not able to attend, please let your instructor know. This courtesy will allow the instructor to dedicate their time to helping other students.

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ONLINE PAPER REVIEW SYSTEM

Have a paper you need reviewed but don't have an English class? Use our online paper review system. You can submit your papers online to be reviewed by one of our English Faculty.
